



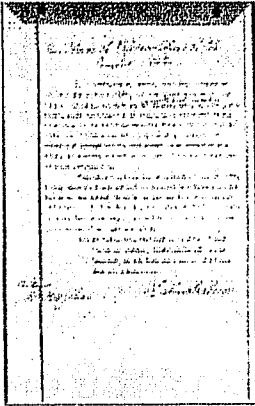

The House of Representatives of the United States :

I, Liliuokalani of Hawaii, renewed their agreement on the 10th day of April, 1877, and proclaimed Queen of the Hawaiian Islands on the 20th day of January, 1891, do hereby protest against the assertion of ownership by the United States of America of the so-called Hawaiian Crown lands amounting to about one million acres and which are my property, and I especially protest against such assertion of ownership as a taking of property without due process of law and without just or other compensation.

Therefore, supplementing my protest of June 17, 1897, I call upon the President and the National Legislature and the People of the United States to do justice in this matter and to restore to me this property, the enjoyment of which is being withheld from me by your Government under what exist as a misapprehension of my right and title.

Done at Washington, District of Columbia, United States of America, this ~~thirteenth~~ 10th day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight.
