**Treaty of Mutual Recognition and Friendship Between
The Republic of Texas and its Peoples
and
the Empire Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah and its Peoples**

Come now the People free and sovereign by the grace and beneficence of God, of and for The Republic of Texas, by and through their delegated agents of authority, and in accordance with the law of the present this treaty of mutual recognition and friendship between the Peoples of The Republic of Texas and the Peoples of the nation Empire Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah, in order that the sovereignty of the Republic of Texas and of both nations be forever preserved.

We hereby acknowledge with respect and appreciation a Treaty of Peace and Recognition from the Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah, United Nations Indigenous Peoples Number 21593, the remnant Ancient Mound Builders of Muu, signed and sealed on the third day of the eleventh month of nineteen hundred and ninety-six of this common era by the Empress Verdiance "Tiara" Washitaw Goston El-Bey.

We further recognize the sovereign rights of the indigenous Peoples who have dwelt and who continue to dwell within our republic, and willingly affirm our respect and our intent before God to deal with all matters fairly and justly in love, peace, and truth.

We anticipate barter and trade in open commerce and cooperation with the Peoples of the Empire Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah in accordance with the law of nations and natural law, for the mutual benefit of the Peoples and nations.



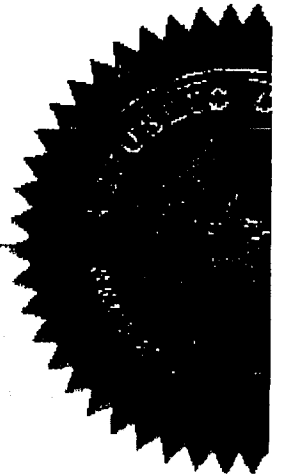

TREATY OF PEACE AND RECOGNITION BETWEEN THE EMPIRE WASHITAW DE DUGDAHMOUNDYAH AND THE REPUBLIC OF TEXAS

Now Comes the Empire Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah, United Nations Indigenous Peoples Number 21593, the remnants of the Ancient Mound builders of Muu, in its full international power as the Sovereign Indigenous Nation of this land, the aboriginal people of the Universe:

Speaking with the Imperial authority of
Her Highness Verdacee "Tiari" Washitaw-Turner Goston El-Bey,
Empress of the Washitaw.

To the people of the Republic of Texas,

Having received your treaty declaration, We recognize your claim is in the Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah, protected by the mountain range and the continental divide and the rivers and waters and winds. Yet, you desire freedom to govern yourselves to which you have every right, as a sovereign province in the Empire, with continual respect and allegiance to your mother, the Washitaw de Dugdahmoundyah Empire, and the respect and allegiance is eternal, and may the Spirit of the Creator guide you forever or you will surely perish like all other nations before you, as the Washitaw has been sustained forever

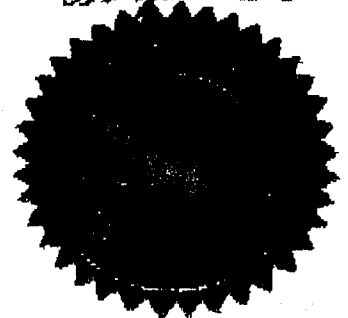
We further recognize and acknowledge the sovereign rights of the many indigenous people and nations who have always dwelled in the territory you claim as your republic. We acknowledge your responsibility before the Great Spirit to deal with them fairly and justly under Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom, and Justice, less you incur the wrath of the Creator.

We expect to barter and trade with you under the natural laws willed by the Creator, as it would mutually benefit the peoples of the land and please the spirit of harmony to see peaceful cooperative constructions.

As the Empire, the Great Mother in Muxi wishes, her children now join together to restore the fundamental freedoms and God-given rights amongst the people who so chose to obey the signs and the times. May the sovereign peoples of the Imperial Washitaw Nation and the sovereign peoples of the Republic of Texas forever live in peace in the enchanted lands of the Empire, reaching out with genuine love to resolve the differences that naturally arise between humans on this earth, before the sight of the One and Only Creator.

Signed and Sented this Third day of the Eleventh month of the year Nineteen Hundred and Ninety-six of this common era at the Imperial Headquarters, Washitaw Proper.
