On Wednesday, June 17, 1998, the U.S. Department of Transportation published the proposed "Drivers License/SSN/National Identification Document" guidelines which all states will be compelled to comply with over the next two years.

The "Notice of Proposed Rule Making" (NPRM) sets out the "standard feature" requirements for driver's license cards and other "identification" documents. States which do not comply will find that their citizens will not be allowed to participate in routine, life-essential functions after the imposed federal deadline of October 1, 2000. Non-conforming licenses will not be accepted for identification by any federal agency. Once implemented, no one in the U.S. will be able to engage in many basic, fundamental societal activities unless they carry with them at all times a conforming government issued identification card. Not surprisingly, under the proposed rule it will become MANDATORY that social security numbers must be submitted in order for anyone to receive a state issued driver's license.

The result is that you literally must have the GOVERNMENT'S PERMISSION to do anything you want to do; Travel, work, buy groceries, rent a car, travel on an airline, receive health care, have a bank account, buy insurance, etc. This makes arguments regarding "rights" and "liberties" moot. Any administrative agency, of which there are hundreds, will simply require and demand a showing of the National ID in order to allow you do anything. People engaging in the simple act of traveling to and from their home will be required to have the National ID and jailed if they refuse. All business, of course, will blindly comply and require the government issued ID card for your purchases.

How far will the People let this government go before they STAND UP AND SAY NO? How long will it be before we realize that the U.S. Government is Oppressing us and attempting to CONTROL EVERY AREA OF OUR LIVES?

Surely, they have "rational" arguments for the implementation of this scheme. Illegal Alien control and Deadbeat Dads head the list. Is controlling every area of the lives of every individual the only answer to these problems? We in the Republic of Texas believe that other answers MUST BE FOUND if there is really a problem.
